Classical Ballet-Professional Program

Our **Professional Ballet** program focuses on training to prepare the dancer to either become a teacher or a dancer in the professional world. The program uses the Royal Academy of Dance syllabus. **This program requires 3-5 days per week depending on the level.** Every level is a two-year program. At the end of each level, students are offered the opportunity to present their work to a RAD examiner.

Professional Program

The dance attire for girls is navy, eggplant or black pinch front tank leotard (Eurotard) w/ matching elastic belt or skirt for syllabus classes, any color leotard for open classes, pink tights, and broken down pointe shoes or leather full or split sole ballet shoes. Boys attire is navy or black tights, tight fitted short sleeved t-shirt or leotard, white socks and shoes.

We are a Licensed Silver Swans studio!** We have a **Performing Arts Preschool** in our facility as well! Please join us this year!!!

Registration Information

Classes start on August 26th and end on June 14th. When you enroll, you enroll for the entire school year. Please refer to the withdrawal policy in the registration packet if you plan to leave class before June 14th. We take new students until January 24th for all classes participating in the recital. All non-performing classes take new students year round.

Tuition can be paid annually, every 12 weeks or every 4 weeks.

There is a \$25.00 non-refundable registration fee per family. Tuition is described in the registration agreement. The Director reserves the right to change teaching staff if necessary.

Military Discount: Show your Military ID and get the registration fee waived. (Must be Active Military and a parent of dancer.)

Recital Information

Recital Policy: A non-refundable recital fee is due on November 1st. \$55 for one recital or \$85 for both ballet and jazz/tap/hip-hop recital. The recitals will then have free admission. Non-performing classes, designated with a ^, do not perform in the recital so no fee is collected. The rehearsals and recitals will be held in lieu of the regularly scheduled classes.

~Recital is Mandatory for all performing classes.~

Costumes: No costume deposit is necessary for ballet classes.

Ballet costumes will be provided. We will be collecting a \$25 cleaning/processing fee per costume on November 1st. *All ballet dancers will need a nude leotard for recital.* **For all Tap, Jazz, Con/Lyrical and Hip-hop classes,** a costume deposit of \$50 per class is due on November 1st with the remainder to be paid when we have ordered the costume and charged your account in the spring. Average costume price is \$100 plus tax. **There are no refunds on costumes once they have been ordered.**

Classroom Limits: Classroom limit is 12 for 3-5 year old dancers and 15 for ages 6 and up. If there are less than 5 dancers the Director reserves the right to shorten/cancel the class. Advanced classes & Hip Hop can have up to 20 dancers.

Boys in ballet! Any families registered at the Dance Center of Spokane are invited to put their sons in ballet on scholarship. If 75% attendance is not maintained, you will be charged for the ballet class(es).

Three Year Old Program:

Our Three Year Old Program is offered Tuesday and Thursday from 9-noon. It features an academic curriculum taught through Group Learning, Creative Movement, Art, Music and Drama. Maximum class size 15.
